In this next assignment students will be using the nonlinear video editing capabilities of Adobe Premiere once again as well as Photoshop and After Effects. Students will use the above mentioned software to create a promotional video for a recruiting DVD. The DVD will be for advertising the art department to high school students in an event sponsored by the department each spring. This, as you may have guessed, is a group project. We will discuss the break down, approach and how to structure this process in class. Each spring during the high school art day event, (HSAD), we document the various activities held all over the art building with video tape and digital photo. This includes the exhibition of HSAD student art work displayed in the main gallery. Those files are saved to disc and are used in this project. Your job is to take the various images, video footage and music you decide is appropriate and assemble them into an interesting, visually exciting and appealing video for high school students in the arts.
