

Art 410 Computer Animation Assignment #10

In this Final assignment students will be using Apple's iDVD to create a finished DVD of all their animations from this class and anything else they would like to include on the DVD. All macs in the lab have the capabilities of burning DVDs. The program we will be using, Apple's iDVD, supports virtually all DVD media, including DVD-R, DVD+R, DVD+RW, DVD-RW, and even DVD+R DL (Double Layer) discs on compatible SuperDrive-equipped Macintosh computers. Keep in mind that you can burn about 2 hours worth of full video onto a DVD-R, +R, +RW & -RW but can burn twice that on the +R DL disks. You will need to purchase at least one DVD recordable media mentioned above for this project. It's your responsibility to choose or create the interface as well as decide on the levels of interaction in the DVD's menu. You will turn this in on the day of your final. Make sure you test your DVD after it has burned to be sure it works in a DVD player at home or on a PC that can play DVDs. If you would like to get the DVD back come see me first thing next semester or make some arrangements with me before you leave for the summer. I will not mail DVDs through the postal service. This project is due on Wednesday May 7th @ 12:45pm; you may turn it in sooner if you wish but no later. Good luck.
